Join us Wednesday, August 17 (6:00–9:00 pm) at La Fonda on the Plaza for an evening to remember.

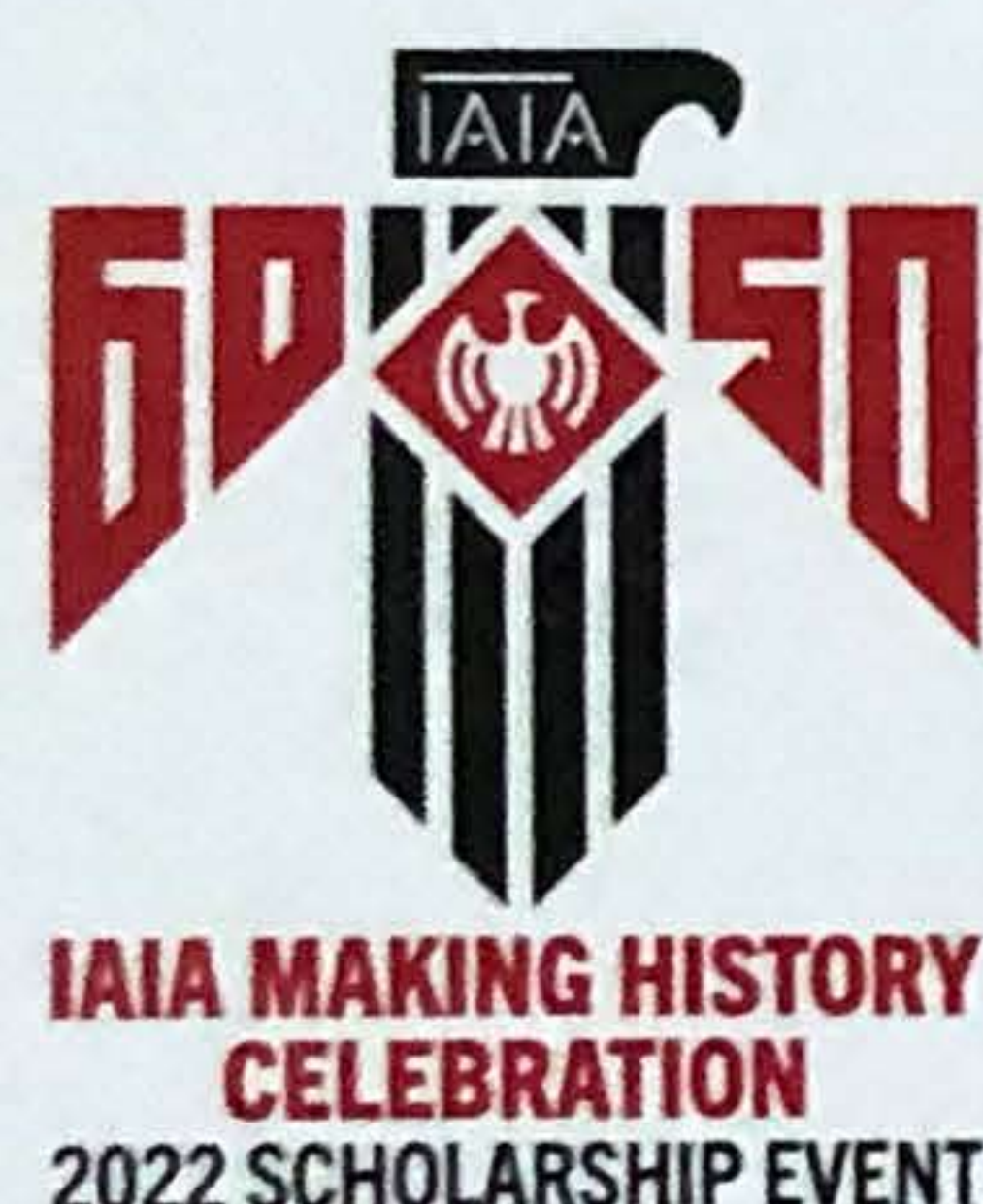
